**Construction is slated to begin in August!!**



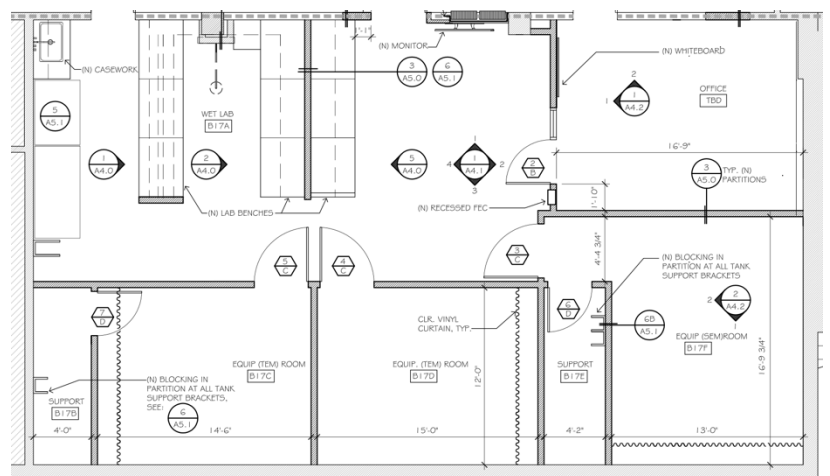
## Current estimated **CLOSURE** period for our move: December - January
